The writer/journalist intern will work alongside Jim Dedelow, Adrianna Alvarez, and other producers and hosts on news reporting. Regarding news reporting, the intern will assist in creating a news podcast as well as assist other producers and hosts with creating news reports for the air. The intern will gain practical experience in professional journalism while contributing to the mission of WJOB and the Legacy Foundation to strengthen journalism and community engagement in Lake County.

Key Responsibilities

- Contributing to the host and producers by providing news reports twice a week (Monday and Thursday).
- Assisting with the creation of a news podcast that will be posted daily
- Learning how to use the equipment, as well as editing software (cameras, microphones, and Adobe Premiere Pro)

Qualifications and Desired Skills

- This position is open to current undergraduate and graduate students.
- Have your own laptop that can support editing software (Adobe, Libsyn, and Dropbox).
- Intermediate journalism skills.
- Beginner editing skills in Adobe (preferred but not required).
- Creating and editing audio from multiple sources, including news stories, weather reports, and local media.
- Recording your voice and making different pre-recorded reports for morning shows.
- Excellent communication and relationship-building skills.
- Independently complete tasks, provide regular status updates, assist in developing project plans and summaries, and document procedures for work completed.
- Must be self-motivated and able to take initiative.
- Reliable transportation and a valid driver's license.

Time Commitment and Compensation

- Approximately 18 hours per week
- Up to 16 weeks from date of hire, with opportunity for extension.
- \$15/hour
