Legacy Foundation's 2024-2028 Strategic Plan will focus its impact in 5 guiding pillars.

In August of 2023, we launched our new 5-year strategic plan, with the idea that community challenges require a deep understanding of the local landscape along with earned trust, intentional listening, and collaboration.

Over 8 months, we spent time listening to and learning from over 100 diverse voices from community members, donors, and grantees through interviews, focus groups, and surveys. A lot of the feedback was positive; however, many respondents were not familiar with the various aspects of our work. With our new strategic plan, it is our goal to remain the same at the core, while boldly expressing our intentions and commitment to the communities we serve and expanding our outreach to those who are less familiar with the multi-faceted work we do.

+ How are unrestricted funds used?

At Legacy, our unrestricted endowed funds are used to support grants to nonprofits and programs that serve Lake County.

+ Why is an unrestricted endowed fund helpful?

Unrestricted funds provide the much needed dollars to support the people and nonprofit organizations addressing current and future needs in Lake County. Our grantmaking for priority community needs is overseen by a board of directors and professional staff to ensure funds are used for maximum impact.

+ What is our process for monitoring grant funds?

After grants have been made from unrestricted funds, Legacy Foundation ensures due diligence by conducting site visits and collecting final reports to learn more about the projects funded and about the work being done by our amazing local nonprofits, ensuring that your gift has been spent in an impactful way.

+ What is the GIFT VIII match timeline?

The timeline for the GIFT VIII Lilly Endowment match is October 1, 2023 – June 30, 2025. Irrevocable pledges made during the matching period are required to be paid by December 31, 2027.

The Lauer Family

Shaping the future they want to see.

Bob and Lauren Lauer were cognizant of the struggles faced by many with less and recognized the impact they could have by starting a fund in their thirties. Inspired by a popular podcast, they committed to giving back 10% of their income annually to actively shape their envisioned future.

The Lauers worked with Legacy's CEO, Donor Engagement Director, and Scholarship Administrator to identify the causes they wanted to support.

By working with the Legacy Foundation to give back locally, we've been able to build a strong sense of connection and purpose within our community, which we deeply value. We hope to inspire other young individuals to join us in contributing to positive change.

In addition to opening a donor advised fund, the Lauers started a scholarship fund that reflected Bob's role at a computer programming school. Discussions with Legacy staff highlighted the shortage of scholarships that support non-traditional forms of higher education, even as the number of students enrolled in such programs continues to steadily increase. The Lauers created the Building the Future Vocational Scholarship, aimed at empowering Lake County residents to pursue vocational or trade school education with the goal of local employment. The collaborative effort not only resulted in the creation of a meaningful scholarship, but also underscored the potential for positive change when community stakeholders work together.

Their advice to peers:

Commit to donating a percentage of your annual salary and then make the contributions on a monthly basis, similar to the common practice of committing a portion of your income to retirement savings.



We integrate giving into our budget, ensuring consistency and fostering a sense of accountability to our commitment to philanthropy. This approach not only allows us to support important causes consistently, but also reinforces the importance of generosity in our lives.

IRA Qualified Distribution



At age 70½ or older, direct your IRA custodian to make a qualified charitable distribution (QCD) to Legacy Foundation. Avoid taxes on transfers of up to \$105,000 from your IRA to our organization, reduce your taxable income, and satisfy your required minimum distribution.

Gift of Grain



By gifting grain to Legacy Foundation, you avoid including the sale of the grain in your farm income, and your taxable income is reduced. Farmers may realize savings on federal and state income taxes and self-employment tax while still deducting the costs of production.

Charitable Gift Annuity



Donate cash or appreciated securities in exchange for fixed annuity payments. Charitable deduction for gift portion of donation; part of payments may be tax-free return of principal; capital gains tax on transfer spread over donor's life expectancy if donor is the annuitant.

After 58 years, the Lake County **Advancement Committee turned over** its reins to the Legacy Foundation.

Since its inception in 1965, LCAC has been identifying major social, economic, and policy issues impacting the citizens of Lake County, educating Lake County leaders and the greater community about these important issues, and engaging in dialogue around these topics.

We partnered with Indiana University for Futurecast, hosting a panel of guest speakers that covered the economic outlook for 2024 locally and beyond. Economists from Indiana University's Kelley School of Business shared their economic outlook for the Region, State of Indiana, and the Nation.



Good news prevailed as the experts discussed a rosier 2024 outlook stating that population growth, a strong economy for workers, and a 5.8% wage increase have worked to put NWI in a place where "the sun is shining brightly on us as we go into the future."

With over 150 Northwest Indiana residents, businesses, and nonprofits in attendance, LCAC member Cal Bellamy passed the baton to President & CEO, Kelly Anoe.

Learning Lab

Strengthening nonprofit capacity and leadership, Legacy Learning Lab supports Northwest Indiana nonprofit organizations through workshops and strategic resources.

Over the year, Legacy Foundation hosted 13 events and workshops, collectively engaging nearly 500 attendees. Topic sessions included employment law, investing, attracting donors, grants, and executive director peer group. Additionally, it supported capacity building initiatives to further support local nonprofits.

GrantStation

Legacy Foundation partnered with GrantStation, an online database of grant opportunities, to offer Lake County serving organizations a discounted one-year membership to GrantStation. Through this partnership, nearly 40 nonprofits have received a discounted membership of over \$600 in savings and have access to thousands of grant opportunities from private and governmental agencies, along with tools to strengthen their grant applications.

Resilia

Legacy Foundation provided 10 local nonprofits a year-long membership to the Resilia platform. Resilia's goal is to amplify philanthropic impact by offering nonprofits access to capacity building support, technical assistance, and one-on-one coaching. By using the variety of available tools, "nonprofits become stronger and more sustainable by building knowledge, developing diversified funding, and tracking their impact." Members accessed over 200 resources in areas of strategic planning, board orientation/development, and fundraising.

Rise NWI

Legacy Foundation's civic engagement program, Rise NWI, empowers residents to create change within their community.

Voter Engagement

Rise NWI engaged over 300,000 NWI residents through digital and in-person education around the 2023 municipal elections. Voters were educated on election dates, making a plan to vote, engaging with candidates, and voter rights. Additionally, through a partnership with the League of Women Voters of the Calumet Area, Rise NWI published VOTE411 Lake County, an online nonpartisan voter engagement hub to educate voters on the positions up for election and the candidates running for office.

While civic engagement is the core of Rise NWI, in 2023, the program implemented initiatives to address time-based community needs.

Health Equity

Our Shot 219

Through a grant from the Urban Institute, and focused on breaking barriers to healthcare, Our Shot 219 assisted in organizing vaccine clinics with local healthcare providers at over 20 accessible locations, including churches, small businesses, and community centers. These clinics provided COVID-19, Flu, Shingles, and other CDC recommended vaccines. Attendees were encouraged to participate in other preventative care screenings at these clinics, such as blood pressure and glucose testing. Through these events nearly 700 vaccines were distributed.

The program's educational campaign developed 50 communication products that engaged 249,000 individuals digitally and over 11,500 residents at various community events. Through developed materials and meaningful one-on-one conversations, the program provided up-to-date accurate information to residents.

Affordable Connectivity Program

Get Connected, Lake County

Get Connected, Lake County assisted households in applying for the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) which provided low-income households free or reduced internet access. Program volunteers visited 42 community events to help residents apply for ACP. Additionally, a digital ad campaign was generated to spread program awareness and eligibility.

NWI BizHub

Strengthening Northwest Indiana's entrepreneurial ecosystem.

During 2023, NWI BizHub expanded its entrepreneurial support to the seven-county Northwest Indiana Region, adding services to Jasper, Newton, Pulaski, and Starke Counties.

NWI BizHub focused on providing one-on-one support, addressing each client's unique business needs. The program brought together hundreds of small business owners through networking and training events, engaging in one-on-one conversations with over 1,500 entrepreneurs and resource partners in the community.


