How do we describe our work in this way? Legacy Foundation's goal is to transform Lake County... neighborhood by neighborhood and encourage philanthropic support to accomplish that goal.

Legacy Foundation has launched several initiatives that give Lake County residents opportunities to build relationships, have funding impact, and have a voice in the future of their communities to fuel positive transformation.

- Over the past five years, Legacy's **Neighborhood Spotlight** has engaged residents of Gary, Hobart, and Griffith in a collaboration to take action on issues important to them.
- On September 26, 2018 Legacy's **On The Table**, gathered nearly 3,000 adults and school children to discuss the strengths and concerns they had about their neighborhood. Now residents can join focus groups that are based on priorities shown in the surveys submitted from **On the Table** discussions.
- **GIFT VII** from Lilly Endowment Inc., a matching gift challenge of \$1.875 million distributed to Legacy this past fall, is matching endowment donations to Legacy's Lake County Community Fund, donor advised funds, and agency funds. Growth of these funds means a greater investment in Lake County's future.

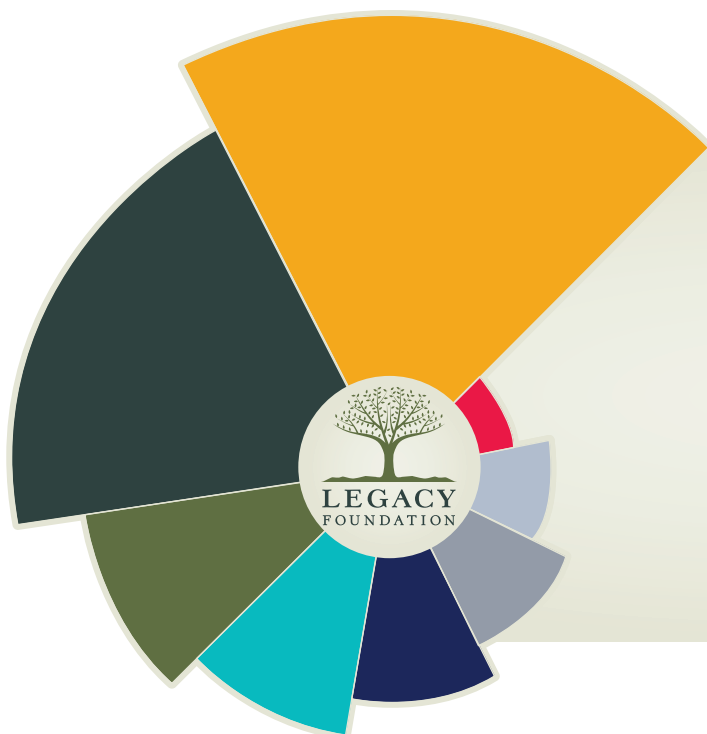

- **Community Outreach:** Volunteers attended over 50 community events to distribute educational information on the 2018 Lake County General Election.
- **Events:** Letter to the Editor Training, Canvassing Training, Local Elections Matter Event, and Monthly Volunteer "Meet Ups".

On the Table is a strategy to identify community needs and encourage meaningful face-to-face dialogue. On September 26, 2018, nearly 3,000 adults and youth participated in year two of On the Table in Lake County. Friends, families, colleagues, and strangers gathered around a meal to have a conversation about what is important for the future of their community and brainstorm solutions.

What we learned from the conversations: **Jobs/economic development and crime are top issues that participants would like to see addressed in their community.**

Participants under 18 years old who completed a survey identified drug use/addiction and violence as the most important issues facing youth in their community.

71% of survey participants say that the area where they live has a strong sense of community, however, 51% feel their community does not provide opportunities for everyone. African Americans and Millennials were among the most likely to say their community does not provide opportunities for all.

Attendees identified nonprofits, community residents, and local government as the most impactful partners for community change.

More than 50% of participants said their conversation led them to connect with new people, learn more about their community, and understand how to take action.

After their On the Table discussions, participants had the chance to submit for a Community Action Award. Ten applicants received a \$1,000 grant to help turn ideas from their conversation into action. Community Action Awards were funded by the South Shore Neighborhood Development Corporation with support from the JPMorgan Chase Foundation and the John S. and James L. Knight Foundation.

SOUTH SHORE NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

After working closely with five Lake County neighborhoods through Neighborhood Spotlight and other programs, Legacy Foundation, with input from community partners, determined that a county-wide community development corporation could help deepen resident engagement and move neighborhoods toward greater success in implementing plans. Launched in 2018, with funding from JP Morgan Chase Foundation, the South Shore Neighborhood Development Corporation (SSNDC) is focused on transforming vulnerable and transitional neighborhoods into healthier places where people could invest their time, energy and resources and where residents are engaged in community problem solving.



IN YEAR ONE

Thomas P. Miller & Associates was selected to lead the strategic planning process for SSNDC, during which future programming would be identified. The resulting plan is a product of interviews and discussions with stakeholders and SSNDC leadership. It is reflective of current issues that challenge the county and is responsive to what community representatives see as the most effective role for the SSNDC within the community. In October 2018, the SSNDC was awarded a USDA grant to address food accessibility issues in East Chicago and Gary.

Through this program, named Lake County Eats Local, the SSNDC will create new and build capacity at eight fresh food markets in these communities. These markets will provide local families access to fresh produce while introducing farmers to local consumers to whom they can sell their produce. They will also participate in the SNAP, WIC, and Senior Voucher programs which will offer low income residents greater access to healthy food.

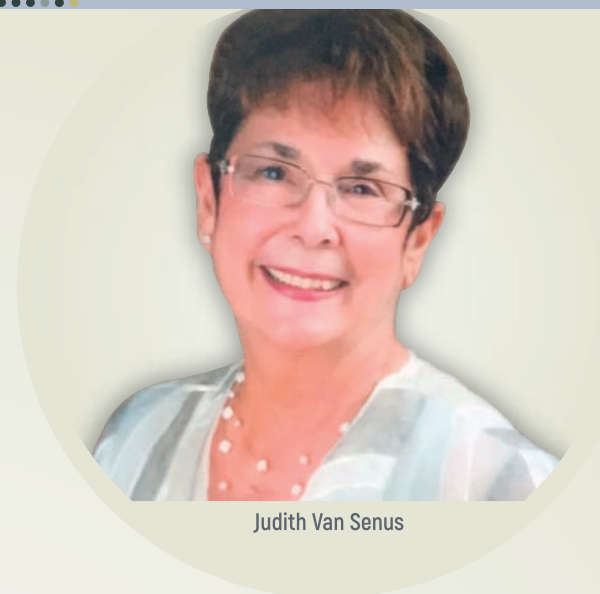

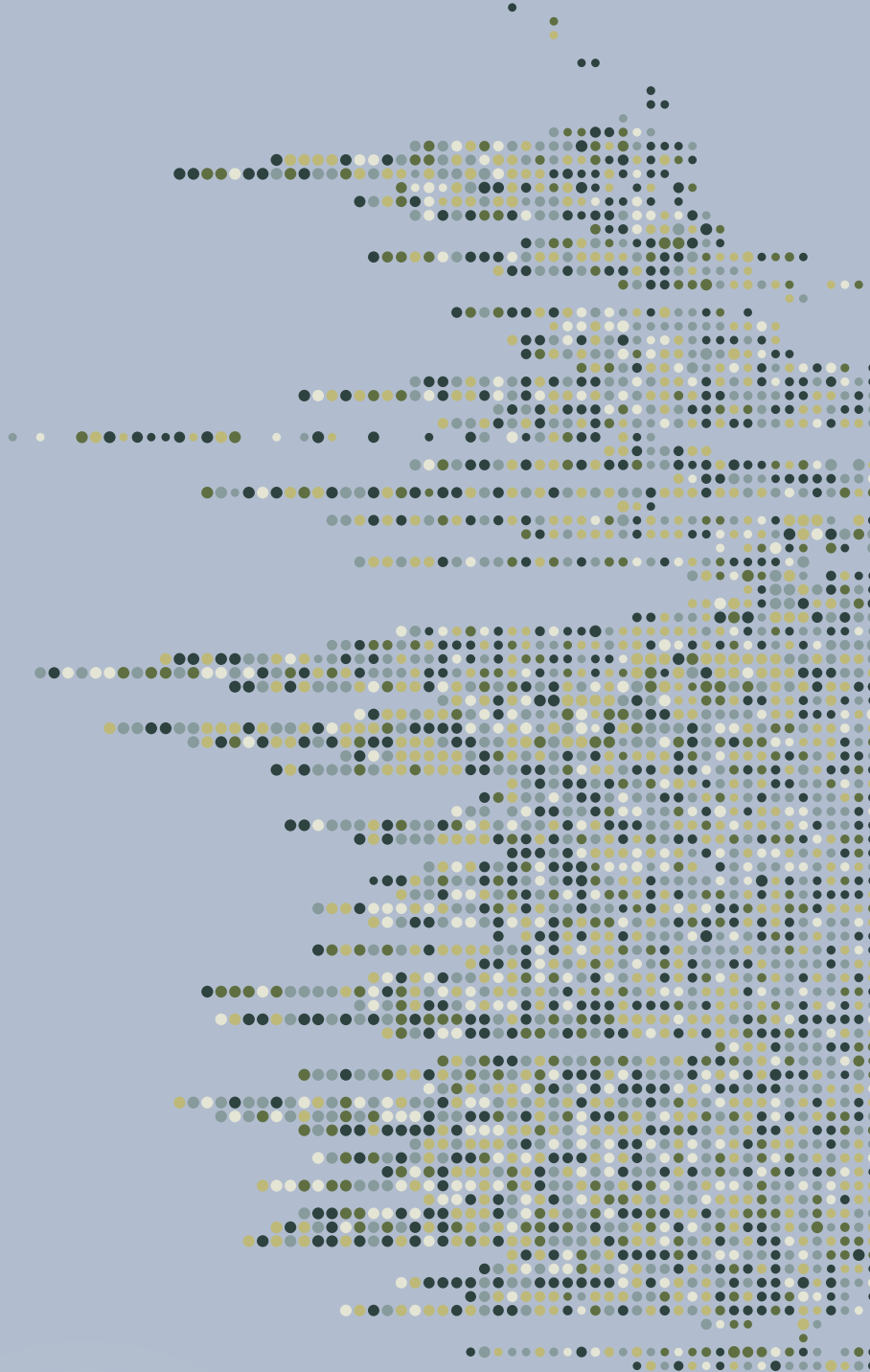
