

## Legacy Foundation Universal Application

Legacy Foundation actively administers more than 35 scholarship funds. Our application process is designed to make it easier and less time consuming for students to apply for the scholarships available through the universal online application. Eligible students may be awarded a scholarship from one or more funds.

Your application must be completed and submitted through the online scholarship system found on the Foundation website, legacyfdn.org.

The 2023 Universal Scholarship application opens
November 1, 2022 and closes February 1, 2023 at 5 PM Central.

Use the chart below to see which scholarships are the best fit for you! You must complete the Legacy Universal Application to be eligible.

Scholarship eligibility requires students to attend an accredited 2 or 4 year public or private institution of higher learning. All scholarships are for full-time students, unless otherwise noted. Renewable awards are for 4 years of undergraduate study and cannot be used for post graduate coursework; all awards are paid directly to the school or may be used for book reimbursement.
